Additional Entry Information

Acknowledgement of entries will be made <u>via email</u> as soon as practicable. Please include <u>legible</u> email address on your entry form. Exhibitors providing email addresses may receive all communication, including confirmation and judging schedule through email. Please ensure all spam -blocking technology is set to allow email from the secretary address. Check junk/spam folders regularly, as some communications will contain .pdf attachments.

If you use an entry service (superintendent, online entry or fax service), please be aware of their terms, additional charges and delivery policies. Entries are processed in the order that they are received at the address of the Show Secretary.

Effective January 1, 2024: An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 (first entry only), an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 for the first entry of a dog and \$3.50 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes will be required for each dog entered at all Licensed or Member Club events. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. All Recording and Event Service Fees are collected by the event-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2 and AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 4)

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Postdated checks, returned checks or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

No refund for duplicate entries. Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6.) No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Notice to Exhibitors

• COVID INFORMATION: All Covid-19 guidelines (including mask wear policy) to be followed at the trial will be included in the final confirmation and judging schedule. All trial decisions will be in accordance with CDC, AKC, state and local guidelines in place at the time of the trial. Exhibitors are expected to follow these guidelines. SSCNNJ is making every effort to supply a safe trial environment. However, exhibitors are entering the trial at their own risk. If you are exhibiting signs of illness, have tested positive or have been otherwise told to self-quarantine due to known Covid-19 exposure, please stay home.

REFUND POLICY:

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in obedience trials. The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee for bitches in season that are unable to compete for that reason. Refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete. The Trial Secretary must be notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. E-mails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered.

- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the
 Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of
 riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to
 open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, Clantyre Show Secretary Services and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, illness or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Option 2, Entry Limits and Waitlist Information

Here's how an Option 2 "All-Breed" Obedience trial works:

We will accept entries for Shetland Sheepdogs <u>first</u>, then accept entries from all other breeds until the entry limit specified is reached (in the order they are received).

Entries open at 9:00 AM Wednesday January 10, 2024 This is the opening date for both "all breed" <u>and</u> Shetland Sheepdogs

Entries close at 12:00 PM (NOON) Wednesday, February 21, 2024 This is the closing date for <u>everyone</u>.

Priority entry for Shetland Sheepdogs ends on February 14, 2024, 12:00 PM (EST).

All-breed entries will then be accepted in the order they were received.

If the trial has not yet filled on February 14, all entries received after February 14 will be treated equally.

All dogs other than Shetland Sheepdog will show as "waitlisted" on their initial confirmation.

Exhibitors entering a breed other than a Shetland Sheepdog will be notified as soon as possible after

February 14, 2024 regarding the status of their entry.

Entries are open to All-American/Mixed Breed dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners program.

Obedience entry is limited to 8 hours judging per day

A wait-list will be established in order to fill openings created by entries that are withdrawn prior to the event closing day. The waiting list will not extend beyond the published closing date and time.

Trial Information

- All judging will be indoors on matted surface. Facility is climate controlled.
- **IMPORTANT NOTE:** The public restrooms are in an elevated detached trailer.
- CRATING: Crating space is limited. No ex-pens. Due to space constraints, unentered dogs may be
 asked to leave. Exhibitors are not permitted to set up prior to 7:30 AM on the first day of the show.
 Exhibitors may use a few crates in the back room.
- PARKING: There is absolutely no parking allowed on the street.
- There is no camping at the show grounds. Motor homes are not allowed.
- Food will not be available on-site.
- Exhibitors are expected to clean up after their dogs. Do not put any dog waste in the garbage cans
 inside the building.
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the
 dog at ringside when required and without being called. All dogs present must be held on a leash,
 or confined to a crate except when being judged or in the designated fenced exercise areas.
- There shall be no drilling or intensive or abusive training of dogs on the show grounds.
- Obedience classes will be run in "small-tall" height order on Saturday, "tall-small" on Sunday.
- Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16 and Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 15. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Transfers will be accepted prior to the day of the trial. - Waiver of Rights—Animals in Distress: If any dog seems to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without proper supervision the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the trial committee and/or the AKC for disciplinary action. All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against Golden Rule School for Dogs or anyone associated with Shetland Sheepdog Club of Northern New Jersey in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating, fire or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time the entries for a show closed. 
AGREEMENT
